Hi Gregg,

Thank you for the meeting!

I would like to change the second bullet of your notes. The facility will be built in two phases, but each phase will have both a fresh and a salt water component. Phase I will include the pipeline, WTP/WWTP, smolt, and grow out tanks, and Phase II will include additions to the smolt and another production building with grow out tanks. The smolt (freshwater) facility will be constructed on the earlier part of Phase I so that the hatchery can begin growing eggs to smolt size and have them ready for the grow out tanks as the grow out facility is being built.

It isn't confirmed if the smolt wastewater could temporarily go to the municipality for 12-18 months until the pipeline is built, so I would leave that out for now until that can be confirmed with the city. Thank you,
