Hi Matt,

We can't do a thing until Andrew gets the Disposal Permit (Solid Wastes Beneficial Re-Use). The actual dredging activity (Natural Resources Protection Act (NRPA)) Application can't be submitted without the Beneficial Re-Use Permit as an Exhibit. My opinion is the potential wetland issue/delineation needs to be resolved ASAP. If it turns out OK, we'll prepare the NRPA now so it is set to go the minute the Beneficial Re-use Permit is issued. If not, we need to find another location yesterday! From your perspective, we (ECO) shouldn't do anything until that is known.

Given the current timetable (Beneficial Re-Use submitted July 1, up to three months of review (Statutory Limit at DEP), submission of the NRPA Application October 1 (same day as Beneficial Re-use Permit received), and up to three months of DEP and Army Corps review), the worst case scenario is a Permit on January 1). Caveats are that the Applications submitted must be perfect (no additional data requests from Agencies) and DEP doesn't procrastinate with accepting them as complete (my understanding is they are waiting as long as possible right now because of work load). We aren't seeing quick turn-arounds at DEP right now on the NRPA side. I'm not sure about Solid Wastes. Andrew may have a feeling he can share with us.

Maybe a Team Meeting is in order if you want to get the work done next winter. I'll check with Prock to see how long it will take to do the work. The good thing there is weather will minimally impact it as it does with at sea disposal.

Would like to touch base with you to see where we are at with the ACOE and permitting, testing results, etc. After talking with Dave Stlaurent at Public Works, Gartly and Dorsky (Andrew Hedrich...spelling) is working on the engineering and DEP permits for the Snow marine park dredge spoils. Could you touch base with them just so that we are on the same page? We've reached out to the cement plant who owns the old Stinson's wharf in the south end, I'm hoping they will let us lease a portion of their pier to off load the spoils from the barge and truck to Snow marine park, this would alleviate us from having to run the trucks through town. We are still working on the funding but it's looking promising and should know early fall of this year.
