



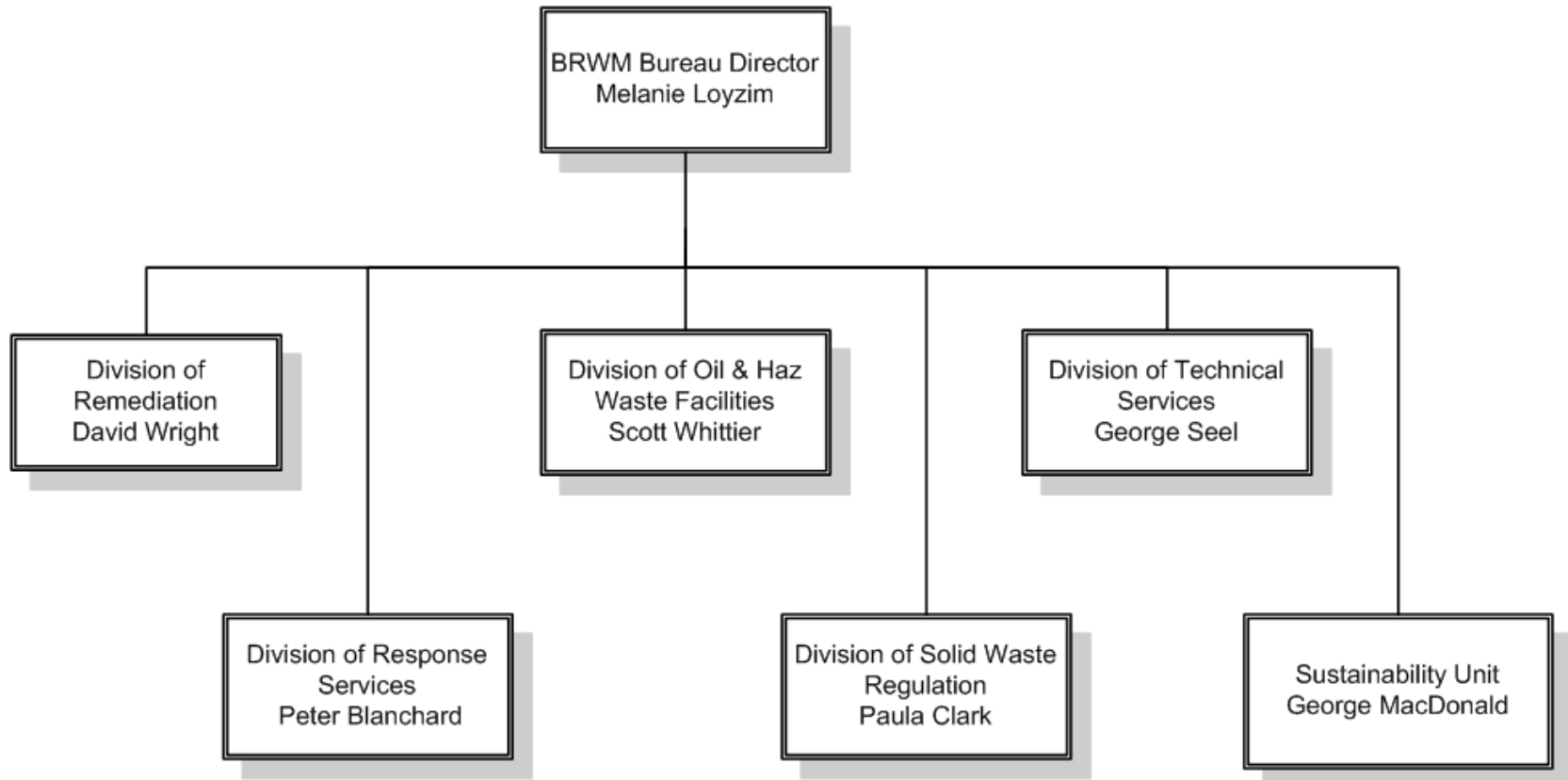

Division of Remediation

- Superfund (CERCLA) sites
- Uncontrolled sites
- Dept. of Defense facilities
- Formerly used Defense facilities (FFUDs)
- Brownfields sites
- Voluntary Remedial Action (VRAP) sites
- Dry cleaner sites
- Lead and asbestos abatement program
- Municipal landfill C&R program



Division of Response Services

- Response to coastal spills
- Transportation incidents
- Home heating oil spills
- UST removals/replacements
- Incident response (Deepwater Horizon)
- Enforcement (meth labs)
- Homeowner complaints
- Staff in four regional offices



Division of Oil & Hazardous Waste Facilities

- Licensing/enforcement of TSD facilities
- Regulation of Terminals
- Corrective measures
- Biomedical waste
- Closure/post-closure stewardship
- UST licensing inspections/enforcement
- Universal/household hazardous waste
- Hazardous waste transporter licensing



Division of Solid Waste Regulation

- Regulation of solid waste transfer, storage, processing, and disposal facilities
- Licensing of non-hazardous waste transporters
- Beneficial use of residuals
- Landfill gas collection and re-use
- Biomass facilities



Sustainability Unit

- Product stewardship program
- Environmental Leader program
- Residuals and sludge composting
- E-waste (computers, CRTs, batteries, thermostats) recycling
- Safer Chemicals in Children's Products
- Pharmaceuticals take-back program
- Toxic chemical reduction

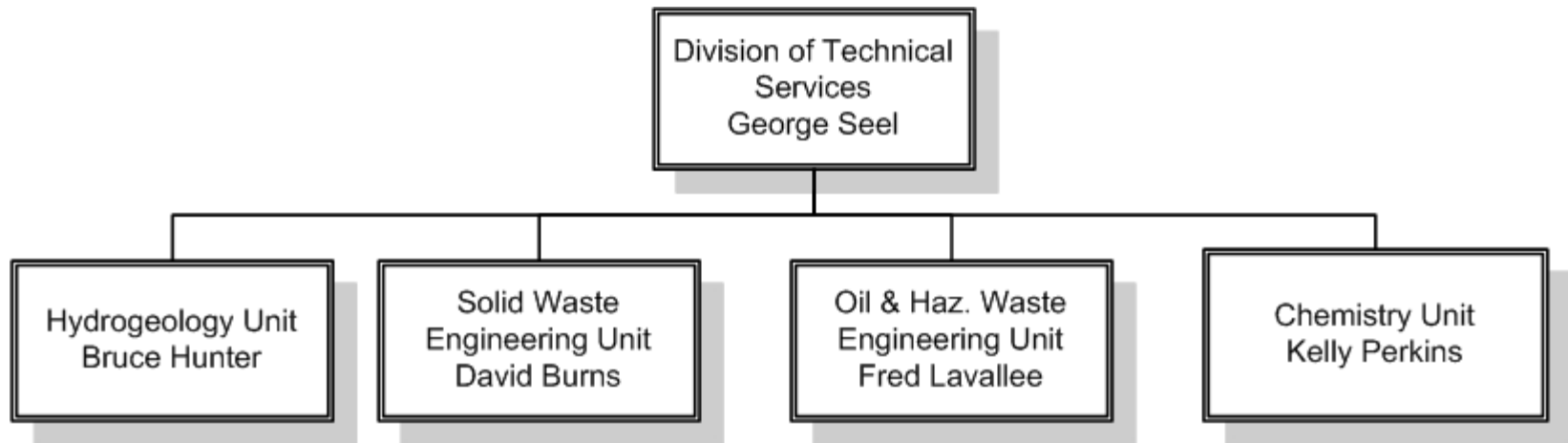


Division of Technical Services
