I am reading through the Bowden Pt. Property Tier 3 app.

A few things jump out at me: it states that there is no significant wildlife; local folks (including my family) hunt deer, grouse, woodcock, black ducks, mallards, bufflehead, whistlers. There are also endangered Barrow's eye whistlers, geese, mergansers, osprey, eagles, red-tail hawks, seals, otters, terns and more. In the spring, eiders migrate through. I see conflicting numbers on wetland destruction. page 79 states loss of 14, 038 sf fresh water wetlands; 28,792 intertidal. Page 82 concludes 15,152 sf loss of intertidal.

Additionally, the letters to the Penobscot Nations (pg 102) include a 525' pier; page 20 describes a 710' pier.

I have only skimmed the application and have not seen the site plan. Look forward to your decision Thursday.
