Thank you for the careful and hard work you do to keep the state of Maine pristine.

Attached are two maps of Bowden Point Road in Prospect ME detailing the location and close proximity of the Hanson well & home (lot 22) to the proposed rock processing facility .

In previous permits it was stated that the land surrounding the proposed facility is undeveloped. Not true...Homes and wells are near by. The Hanson property was purchased March 15, 2018 and the home was built in 2019.

Our environmental concerns are many.

- The disturbing of the mercury that is settled at the river bottom.
- The drawing of 50,000 gallons of water from the aquifer to be used at proposed facility each day may harm the quality and quantity of drinking water for neighbors.
- The effects of silica dust on the neighbors of Bowden Point.
- The effects of sound decibels for the surrounding residents and eagles and wildlife along this area.
- The disturbance of the peace and tranquility of our town.

This is an enormous project that will harm and effect the Penobscot River and the town of Prospect for generations.

I am a concerned and interested person. Please keep me informed of the permitting work Maine DEP is receiving from "Bowden Point Properties, Inc." as it pertains to this project.
