To Whom It May Concern:

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") recently audited the "former Maine State Prison" site ("Site"), located along Main, Wadsworth and Ship Streets, for compliance with the conditions set forth in the Voluntary Response Action Program ("VRAP") No Further Action Assurance (NFAA) letter issued to the Town of Thomaston on November 9, 2005. This audit was completed with the intent of assessing the success of our program. Our records indicate that you are the current owner of the Site.

As a result of this audit, the Department has determined that the Site is currently not in compliance with the conditions required to receive liability protections under the VRAP, as the Department has not received a recorded copy of the VRAP NFAA letter. As required in the November 9, 2005, NFAA letter, a copy of the document must be recorded at the Knox County Registry of Deeds. If the document was recorded, please provide a recorded copy to the Department. If the document was never recorded, please record the document and provide a copy to the Department. Please be aware that if the document is not recorded, the Town of Thomaston does not qualify for liability protection under 38 M.R.S.A. § 343-E.
