January 13th 2010

SIAG Attending: James Gilway, Scott Dickerson, Doug McMullen, Bob Ramsdell, Duane Scott, Deane Van Dusen

Public Attending: Marietta Ramsdell

- Bob and Marietta reported on the DOC grant application for trail development and a natural resource inventory that was submitted on Oct 30, 2009. Results are expected in March 2010.
- Duane reported on the lack of response to the RFEI. This was expected based upon the global economic slowdown.
- Duane spoke about the MaineDOT Searsport Main Street planning effort and how this was dovetailing with Gateway 1. James mentioned that the town was interested in a Scenic Byways designation and the possibilities for federal funding and economic development. Duane mentioned that the town should contact Fred Michaud, MaineDOT Scenic Byways Coordinator for more info.
- Bob asked about obtaining a Sears Island directional sign to be posted on Route 1 for visitor orientation.
   Duane recommends speaking with Steve Landry from Traffic Engineering for information.
- Bob mentioned problems in the last storm regarding snow removal in front of the gate. Visitors complained about how the plow left a near impassable windrow that blocked access for 4-5 days before being removed. The town was concerned about emergency access being blocked. Bob was wondering if the snow could be removed in a more timely manner? This was referred to Rhonda Fletcher, M&O Mid-coast Region 2.
- FOSI would like to establish a trail down the east side of the island from the Education & Maintenance Center Parcel. The SIAG decided to wait on this until the natural resource inventory was completed. It is expected that this inventory will be done by Dec 2010.
